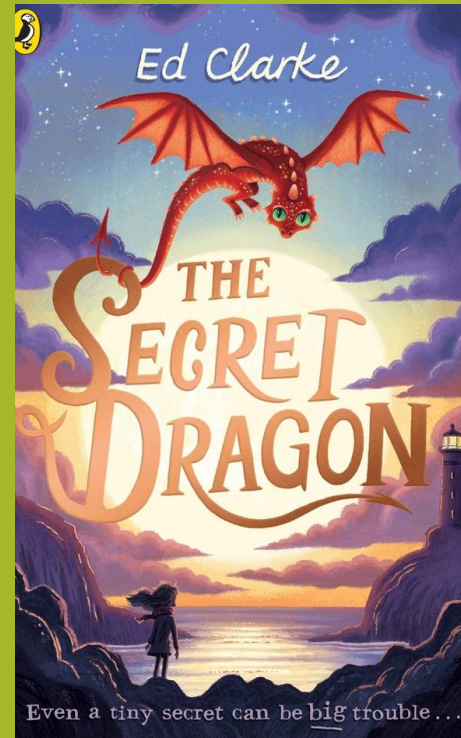
Reminders:

Reading and times tables

English

Our first unit will use the story 'The selfish giant' by Oscar Wilde. This text will help us explore themes around dreams, courage and compassion. We will create letters, diaries, reports and a final narrative inspired by the themes of the book.

Our second unit uses the book 'Winter's child' to create poetry, setting descriptions and retellings.

Science

To understand what a force is and how they allow things to move. A very practical unit, investigating the effect of forces, friction and how magnets work and their uses.
